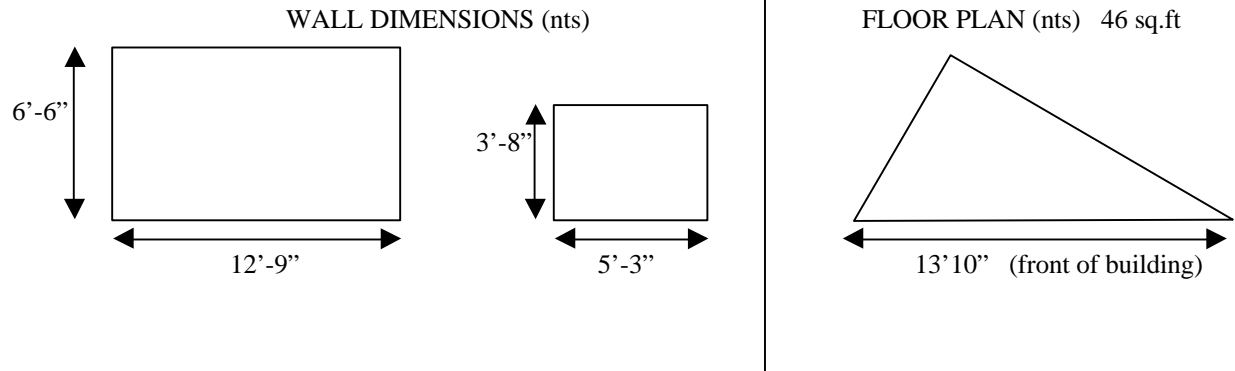

Guidelines for displaying artwork in window

Window Dimensions:



Schedule:

1. Schedule a time to meet with Peckham & Wright Architects, Inc. to show work, or photos of work. Peckham & Wright Architects Staff will determine if the work will be appropriate for the Tenth Street Gallery Window.
2. The Peckham & Wright Architects Receptionist will contact you approximately two weeks prior to your scheduled month to schedule a time to set up.
3. Please fill out a Tenth Street Window Gallery Inventory Form.

Exhibit Set Up:

1. Exhibits will generally run from the beginning to the end of the month, unless changes are discussed prior to exhibit.
2. Normal wear and tear to the wall and display area is expected, but exhibits must not significantly damage the facility.
3. Artist will provide any signage for artwork or artist identification. Price lists may be included in signs, or a list may be left with the Receptionist.
4. Artist will set up the exhibit.
5. Please be aware that the window is very near Peckham & Wright Architects, Inc. employees operating a professional office. A respectable noise level must be maintained, and interruption to daily activities must be minimal. Hammering is acceptable to hang work, but shouting to people outside the window is not appropriate. NO POWER TOOLS may be used for the exhibit.
6. Artist will provide all hangers/nails, etc.

Exhibit:

1. Peckham & Wright Architects, Inc. will not directly sell work. Any work sold is done at the convenience of the Artist.
2. Peckham & Wright Architects, Inc. reserves the right to remove an exhibit for any reason deemed necessary.
3. Peckham & Wright Architects, Inc. assumes no responsibility for damage to artwork at any time.

Exhibit Take Down:

1. Artist will dismantle and remove all work, nails, and hangers.
